- **ISTIDAMA** is a Lebanese non-profit organization specializing in initiating and managing sustainable development projects across all regions of Lebanon.
- In light of the unprecedented humanitarian crisis in Lebanon, Istadama is currently involved in providing aid (mattresses, pillows, blankets, food, medications, sanitary items, clothes and shoes) to the displaced who are staying under dire conditions in schools, centers and apartments (Crisis Support).

HOW DOES ISTIDAMA WORK?

Istidama works in the following manner:

1. In addition to various schools and centers, it has been able to reach (via a network of local “Crisis Cells” made up of volunteers in various regions) needy families staying in apartments who have been under-served thereby balancing the distribution of aid between the displaced staying in schools/centers and those in apartments.
2. All the supplies and goods are sourced from Lebanese manufacturers and **MADE IN LEBANON**.
3. Its overhead cost is minimal especially since it relies heavily on volunteers who work tirelessly for long hours for no cost.
4. Its founders have been able to leverage their contacts and relations to obtain supplies for exceptionally low prices, rent a warehouse and crisis operation office at no cost, obtain transportation to all regions from Advanced Car Rental at no cost and receive a substantial amount of canned food, shoes, clothes, blankets and packaging materials as in kind donations.
